DEBT: When I arrived as your Pastor in June of 2002, our debt to the Diocese was \$344,013.37. As of December 26, 2004 our debt is at \$182,929.91. The principal on the debt has been reduced by \$161,083.46 and we have paid \$35,844.61 on interest. We have reduced the accumulating interest from \$47.00 a day to \$24.00 a day. The quicker we rid ourselves of this debt the better we will be. If you have been able to contribute to the monthly Debt Reduction Collection, we thank you for your generosity! If you haven't yet contributed, would you consider helping us overcome our debt so as to prepare for the future?
