Thank you for your great response to my homily last weekend. Together we can re-imagine our life in the Church.

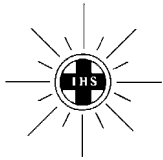

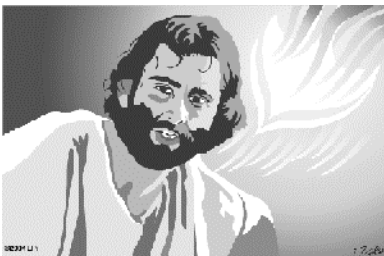
