DAILY MASS, during the Season of Lent will be at 7:00AM and 12:10PM. Many people make it a daily practice to go to Mass during Lent.

LENTEN MISSION will be offered the first week of Lent, Mon – Wed, Feb 14-16 at 7:00PM. Our native son and newly ordained priest, Fr. S. Matthew Glover will be our Mission speaker
