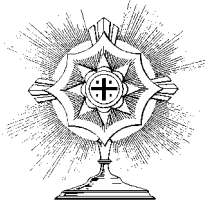

We have been so blest that during these past 6 years we as a parish explored what our parish family needed, to make it "Safe and Secure for the Future." After many meetings with parish committees and receptions with parishioners, a successful Capital Campaign was launched and we raised 1.1million dollars to address the needs we determined were necessary and crucial. Of course, that money can only be used to address the projects for which we raised it. Hopefully, with your generosity we can explore most of them. As I am sure you are well aware, I can not take money from the Campaign and use it for something else that was not part of the scope of the Campaign, as honorable as other projects might be. **HOWEVER**, as I mentioned so often, we can not just look at our own needs but we have to be mindful of the needs of the poor. Next week we will begin again the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal. Our goal is \$54,400.00.
