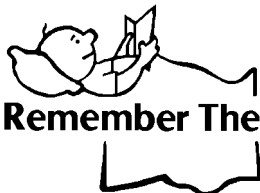

APPOINTMENT

Our Bishop, Thomas Tobin, this week, appointed our pastor to be the Vicar Forane (Dean) of the East Bay Deanery, which encompasses parishes from Rumford to Bristol. Each Diocese is divided into Deaneries. Our diocese has twelve. A deanery is a territorially area in which the parishes are to be united in their proclamation of the Gospel. It is the responsibility of the Dean according to Canon Law, "to coordinate and promote pastoral activity in his deanery, working closely with the Bishop in seeing that the clerics of his vicariate lead a life in keeping with their state and perform their duties diligently. The dean is to see that religious functions are celebrated according to the prescripts of Canon Law and that the beauty and elegance of Churches are maintained. He is to have a concern for the spiritual well being of the clergy of his deanery with a special concern for those who may be gravely ill." The appointment is for a term, at the discretion of the Bishop, and with the responsibilities, the written title of the dean appearing in formal publications is the Very Reverend Henry P. Zinno, Jr.

PACKETS WERE MAILED LAST WEEK!

Registration Packets for students in grades 1-8 for the 2010-2011 school year were mailed last week, August 2nd. If you have a child previously enrolled in the program and did not receive the packet, please contact the Religious Education office at 253-5052. If you have a child entering grade 1 (children must complete grade 1 before beginning sacrament preparation in grade 2) or are new to the parish, you may contact the office and the information will be sent.

CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION: A letter regarding Confirmation Registration was also mailed last week to all eligible candidates. Eligible candidates are active parishioners attending mass regularly, having completed grade 7 and 8 in our religious education program, or having graduated from a Catholic elementary school. Catholic high school students must participate in the preparation program.
