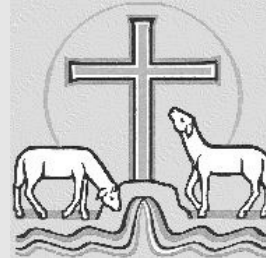

**HOLY WEEK**

Holy Week is the most solemn week of the Church's year. Our participation in this Sacred Triduum draws us all into the saving mysteries of our redemption. The celebrations and services of Holy Week are listed below:

**PALM SUNDAY:** Christ is acclaimed as Lord and King to cries of Hosanna to the Son of David. We receive Palm Branches to remind us of Jesus' solemn entrance into Jerusalem. Palms are blest and distributed at all our Masses on Palm Sunday.

**CHRISM MASS:** Each year, the Bishop, at the Chrism Mass, blesses all the oils that are used in the Sacraments throughout the year. This Mass will take place on Monday evening at 7PM at the Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul in Providence. All are welcome!

**FAST & ABSTINENCE:** Good Friday is a day when we fast: only one main meal is to be taken and likewise we abstain from meat.

**LIVING STATIONS OF THE CROSS** Each Holy Week our children put on a wonderful living Stations of the Cross. This year it will take place Tuesday Evening, April 3 at 7:00PM in the Church. Don't miss this most awesome and prayerful event!!

**DAILY MASS:** Mon, Tues, Wed. 7AM & 12:10PM.

**HOLY THURSDAY:** The Solemn Mass of the Lord's Supper, the celebration of the MANDATUM, and the Eucharistic Procession take place at 7PM. Adoration at the Altar of Repose until Midnight.

**GOOD FRIDAY:** Stations of the Cross are at 3PM, the Solemn Service of our Lord's Passion at 7PM.

**HOLY SATURDAY:** The Easter Vigil with the blessing of the new fire, the blessing of the Easter water, and the Renewal of Baptismal Promises along with Adult Baptism and Confirmation take place at 7PM.
