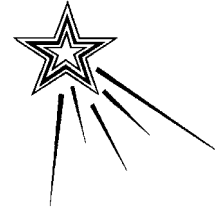

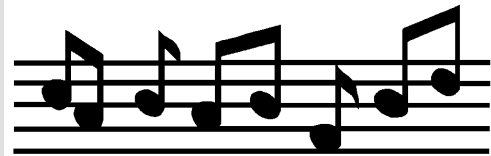

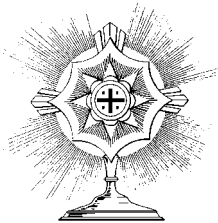

JANUARY 21st and JANUARY 22nd

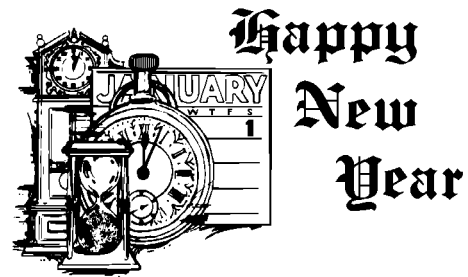
