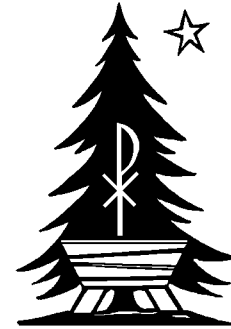
NOCTURNAL ADORATION SOCIETY
