Each year the Church gives us this sacred season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to help us prepare well for Easter. Here at Mount Carmel there are a variety of ways for us to partake in this season:

**DAILY MASS** during the season of Lent will be at 7AM and 12:10PM, Saturday morning at 9:00AM

**LENTEN MISSION** will take place Monday through Wednesday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:00PM. Fr. David Engo will be our speaker.

**RICE BOWLS** are a way to assist with our almsgiving during Lent. Place your spare change/bills in the bowl each day. These monies will be collected as the second collection on PALM SUNDAY to assist Catholic Relief Services in the great work that agency does throughout the world.

**EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION** takes place on the Fridays of Lent beginning after the 12:10 Mass and concluding with Stations of the Cross and Benediction at 7:00PM.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** each Friday evening at 7:00PM.
