FIRST PENANCE PARENT MEETING will be held on January 19th at 7:00PM in the church.

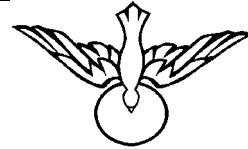

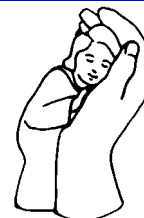
