**DEAR PARISHIONERS**

The year 1899 was a momentous one!! The first of January of that year saw the end of Spanish rule in Cuba. Later on in the year, BAYER registered aspirin as a trademark, the PAPER CLIP was invented, SAN PELLIGRINO water was bottled for the first time (Thank God), and K-MART was founded! (Double Thanks!!). 1899 saw the birth of Duke Ellington and Ernest Hemingway!

But of course, we here at Mt. Carmel know that **THE** most important thing that happened in 1899 was the celebration of the feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel for the first time here in Bristol by the Italian Immigrants who came to this area of the East Bay, with very little but their faith. Indeed, the Catholic Faith's foundation in the state of Rhode Island finds its first record here in Bristol! According to our Diocesan Archives, the first registered Baptism in Rhode Island took place in Bristol in 1810, when Fr. Francis Matignon visited Bristol and baptized four children whose last names were Catalogne, Guinet, Chariteau, and Nicholas!

And so, rich with this history, our parish of Mt. Carmel and this community of Bristol celebrates for the 108<sup>th</sup> time, the glorious feast of Our Lady, Queen of Carmel. From our Chief Marshal's Reception today in the Parish Hall, to our spiritual Triduum, Mon – Wed at 7:00PM, the Opening Mass, Thursday at 7:00PM, the joyful festivities on the grounds Friday – Sunday, and ultimately the Living Rosary, Procession, and Solemn Benediction of the Eucharist on Sunday, we join our ancestors of old in this most beautiful traditions of our heritage! 1899 – 2006: it is our history! So, do join us as we honor our patroness, the Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel
