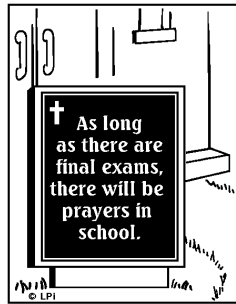
EAST BAY COALITION THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE:
