90th ANNIVERSARY HISTORY

On the weekend of November 5, 2007, nearly 90 years after the first collection of our parish which amounted to \$76.79 was taken, the basket was passed and \$5,992.00 was collected. In addition, on that same weekend, another \$2,033.00 was given for Debt Reduction and \$1,545.50 was contributed for Monthly Maintenance. The First month of the parish IN 1917 saw total expenses at \$278.30. The month of OCTOBER 2007 saw Church expenses and salaries to be \$40,223.80 (not including School expenses and salaries) and payment on the Debt Principal to be \$2,913.86.



CONCERT FOR THE EPIPHANY: Our concert this year (the 12th Day of Christmas) falls on the actual anniversary of our parish, January 7th. Our new Bishop, the Most Rev. Thomas Tobin has been invited and has accepted the invitation. As always we are looking for a sponsor for the concert so that we would not have to charge admission.
