SAFE AND SECURE FOR THE FUTURE:

Through an additional bequest from the estate of Joseph and Ruth Caranci our Capital Campaign has now surpassed the 1.1 MILLION dollar mark!! Our current project is going on in the school with the Fire Alarm upgrade, and as more of the pledges are redeemed we will begin work on the Fire Alarm system in the Church, re-wiring the Church and then we will make a decision on what to do with the pews in the Church: replacing them or refinishing them. We hope you have been able to keep current on your pledges. So far, \$646,014.29 has been redeemed and \$625,607.92 has been spent on the various projects and endeavors of the campaign
