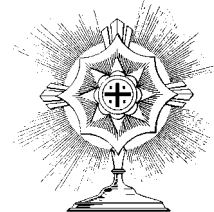

LENT 2008

Lent began last Wednesday as we were signed with blest ashes to signify our entrance into this penitential season. Each year the Church gives us this sacred season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to help us prepare well for Easter. Here at Mount Carmel there are a variety of ways for us to partake in this season:

THE LENTEN MISSION will take place **THIS MONDAY - WEDNESDAY**, February 11, 12, & 13 at 7PM. Fr. Michael Colello, Secretary to the Bishop will be our speaker.

DAILY MASS during the season of Lent will be at 7AM and 12:10PM, Sat. morning at 9AM.

THE RICE BOWLS are a way to assist with our almsgiving during Lent. Place your spare change/bills in the bowl each day. These monies will be collected as the second collection on **PALM SUNDAY** to assist Catholic Relief Services in the great work that agency does throughout the world.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION takes place on the Fridays of Lent beginning after the 12:10 Mass and concluding with Stations of the Cross and Benediction at 7PM.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS each Friday evening at 7PM.

CONFESSIONS are heard every Saturday from 4 – 4:45PM. Likewise on the Tuesday of the Mission, **FEBRUARY 12**, there will be a number of priests available for confession.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are to be days of **FAST** (only one main meal should be taken and **ABSTINENCE** (no meat should be eaten. **LIKEWISE**, all the **FRIDAYS** of Lent are days of **ABSTINENCE**.
